The Nova Scotia International Student Program brings students from around the world to Nova Scotia public schools to learn our language and culture. Be an integral part of a student's learning experience—become a host family.

This is a great opportunity for your family to experience and share culture first hand. Your family will be matched up with a student and they will participate in your daily family routines.



Host Families receive a tax free monthly stipend to help cover the cost of food and any extra transportation expense

Students stay for periods of 2 to 10 months

Ongoing support is provided by an experienced Homestay

Coordinator

You will learn about and communicate with your student before arrival

Host Families are asked to provide a private bedroom, 3 balanced meals a day and inclusion in family activities
